I DARE YOU – ENGLISH-SPEAKING CULTURES

Feladatmegoldás időtartama:	25 perc
Eszközigény:	papír, fénymásoló, olló
A feladat által fejlesztett készségek:	- beszédértés - szövegértés
A feladat rövid átfogó ismertetése magyarul:	A tanulók kis csoportokat alakítanak, a csoportok egymással versenyeznek. A feladatkártyákat, összesen tízet, egy kalapból húzzák ki a tanulók egymás után. Minden kártyán egy feladat szerepel. Ha a tanuló sikeresen végrehajtja a kártyán lévő feladatot (pl. „Betűzd az <i>orange</i> szót!”, „Emeld fel négyszer a jobb lábad!”), a csoport megkapja a kártyán szereplő pontot. A csoport tagjai segíthetnek egymásnak.
